HOMework POLICY



Homework is set for all children on four nights per week. This can take many forms but will usually include reading, spellings, maths/literacy, topic work, religion etc.

The approximate time that children should spend on homework is set out below. It is important that children complete their homework as this is a way of reinforcing work done in class.

Parents can support the school's homework policy by:-

- Ensuring that all homework is completed
- Providing your child's class teacher with a note in the event that homework has not been completed
- Maintaining regular communication with the class teacher if you notice that your child is having difficulty with an area of their homework

If your child experiences any problems with homework please follow the procedures as set out below:-

- Contact teacher
- Contact Principal

In terms of time spent on homework the following guidelines apply:-

P7	One hour
P6	50 minutes
P5	40 minutes
P4	30 minutes
P3	20 / 25 minutes
P1 / P2	10 / 15 minutes

These are guidelines and may vary at certain times of the year/ special events.
